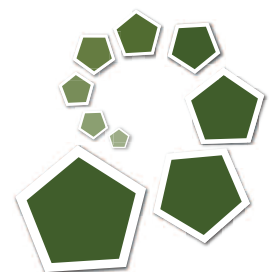
Puzzles and Games

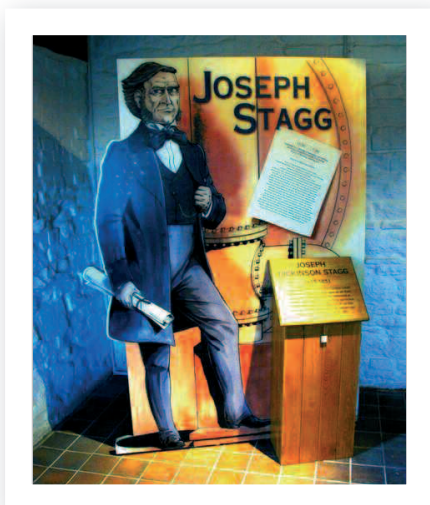
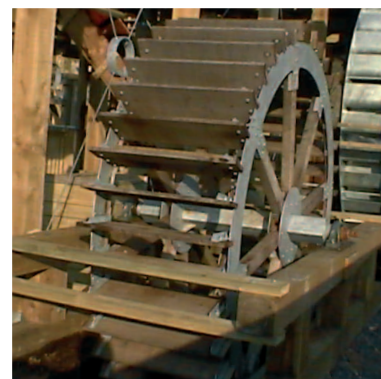
