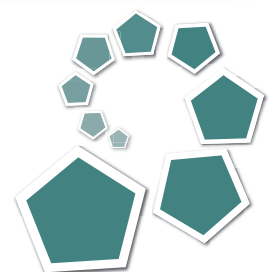
Accessibility

The Neo's large colour touchscreen plays video, audio, maps, images, text and menus. It scores highly in terms of accessibility with the player operated via the main daisy-wheel buttons on the unit (as an alternative to its touchscreen interface). Virtual buttons can be redesigned with a choice of colour contrast and font size, The whole interface disappears off the screen, when not required, to maximise available space.

Using the Video Guide Creator™ software, and filming trained Interpreters in Sign Language, the Orpheo Neo is ideal for deaf visitors.
